On a volunteer basis, you may share your writing, comment on fellow writers’ work, and receive feedback from fellow writers.

Part I: 10-minute presentations on reading as a writer (up to 5 presenters)

Break: 10 minutes

Part II: Writing drill (15 minutes for writing, 10 minutes for sharing writing results, and 15 minutes for round-table discussion)

- Members of the audience reflect on their own reading habits and skills, and adopt the presented ideas to write a reflective piece about their own reading experience as a writer.
